- Diagrama's interview and application process.
- All volunteers must comply with and sign Diagrama's confidentiality agreement, safeguarding and Data Protection policy.

- Complete, in full, the induction training set out for the role.
- Always have a badge/ID visible when representing Diagrama.

Volunteers must:

- Volunteers must always respect Diagrama's health and safety policy and that of any other premises that may be used.
- Volunteers must always report any health and safety concerns to a member of Diagrama staff.
- Volunteers must immediately notify a member of Diagrama staff if you are unable to attend a volunteer role/event.
